Traditionally, harlequin ("clown" in French) patterns were based on the 11th century court performers' costumes, though there is something quite elegant about these updated takes. The Pantalone console has a symmetry and bold palette that evokes a '60s-style mod, while the Black Jack floor lamp is a more dramatic, black-and-white homage. An equilibrium approach is taken by Globe Zero with the Harlequin sofa; it's more subdued, but still playful. And for a minor retouch, the Harlequin rug by Jonathan Adler is contemporary and midcentury at once!
